Ever Dream of Running for Office? 2002 is Your Chance!

The Jeffrey for Governor campaign is seeking to empower New York's youth by recruiting young activists to run for office. Our generation has bold new ideas to improve our communities. We need our voices in the political debate, bringing our own experiences to the table. We need leadership ready to represent.

Libertarians believe in liberty – we should be free to make our own choices without government interference, so long as we don't hurt others. Libertarians are often thought of as liberal on social issues and conservative on economic issues. There is no litmus test to run for office with us but you should agree with our principles. To learn more about us, please visit our website: www.lp.org.

The Libertarian Party is not recognized as an official political party by New York State, so we must run as independents. To get on the ballot, our candidates must collect thousands of signatures from voters registered in their district during a six-week petitioning period that lasts from July 9 until August 20.

State Assembly and Senate require 1500 and 3000 signatures, respectively. Anyone 18 years old or over can run for these offices, so long as you have lived in New York State for the past 5 years and lived in your district for the past year. Both offices are two-year terms with an annual salary of \$80,000.

United States Congress has a 3500-signature requirement. You must be 25 years old to run and have been a U.S. citizen at least 7 years. There is no residency requirement other than to be living in New York State on Election Day. Congressional terms are also two years, at an annual salary of \$140,000.

Most people can collect 20 signatures an hour, so running for Assembly requires 75 hours of work (or 12 hours each week). Higher offices require twice the work. Alternatively, professional petitioners are available for about \$1 a signature.

The petitions will cover multiple offices. Ideally, two Assembly, a Senate and a Congressional candidate will all work together, gathering 900 signatures each. Don't be discouraged if you can't commit to collect all your signatures – please still apply to run. We hope to have additional resources to help where needed.

So consult your friends and family, and dream about changing the world. Then submit your application and we'll turn that passion into a political campaign.
